2019 Milestones

- Staff presented the concept to City Council on 7/2/19
- Staff continues to work with development community to explore the feasibility

2020 Next Steps

- Staff is conducting a series of meetings with stakeholders on building a crime prevention program that will ensure safety and security of construction sites. First meeting was held on February 5, 2020.
- Finalize Ordinance – bring to City Council for adoption, implement and manage program.

Direction Needed from City Council

- Approval of program
- Adoption of Ordinance to require security standards on construction sites

Opportunities to be Leveraged

- Build a sustainable program that will lower criminal opportunities within the entire city
- Maintain the program with the possibility to expand crime prevention to include rental licensing program

Potential Challenges

- Developers push back
- Staff time to manage the programs
